Carl Johnson, BHA's Director of Capital Funds, was recently deployed for two weeks to Texas working as the safety officer with CT-1 DMAT (disaster medical assistance team) responding to Hurricane Harvey. Carl was part of the DHS/HHS Federal response teams that handled missions in Dallas, Houston, and Fort Bend, Texas.

"DMATs are designed to be a rapid-response element to supplement local medical care until other Federal or contract resources can be mobilized, or the situation is resolved. DMATs deploy to disaster sites with sufficient supplies and equipment to sustain themselves for a period of 72 hours while providing medical care at a fixed or temporary medical care site. The personnel are activated for a period of two weeks."

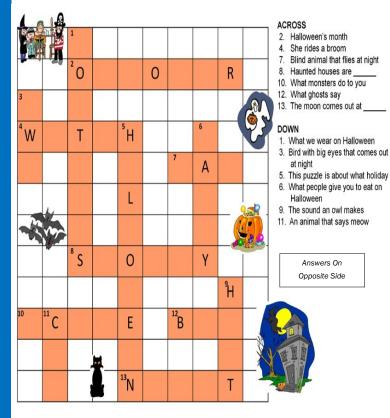
Hi everyone,

Recipe

Easy Apple Crisp

Preheat Oven to 375 degrees. Lightly grease an 8" baking dish.

2 1/2 C. Peeled, Cored and Sliced Apples

1 C. Sifted All Purpose Flour

1 C Granulated Sugar

½ tsp. Ground Cinnamon

¼ tsp. Salt

½ C. Butter, Softened

Arrange apple slices evenly in prepared baking dish. Sift ALL dry ingredients; cut in butter and use pastry blender or fork to mix (should resemble coarse cornmeal.) Then, sprinkle over apples. Bake in preheated oven until topping is golden; about 40 to 45 minutes. Cool slightly before serving.
